Video filters can also be a fun way to personalize your Zoom experience.

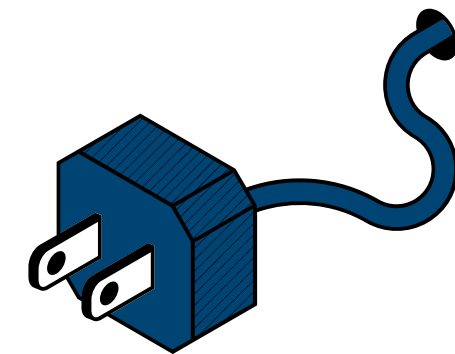
